**Section A 20 marks**

**Answer ALL questions in this section.**

1. The time-out ends and the referee beckons Team GC Foster onto the playing court. The Team Head Coach continues to instruct his team which again remains in the team bench area. The referee beckons Team GC Foster onto the playing court. What penalty will be given to GC Foster for failing to acknowledge the referees' signal?
  - a. The referee shall give a warning to the GC Foster Head Coach
  - b. After Team GC Foster finally enters the playing court, a time-out, without warning, shall be charged on Team GC Foster
  - c. If no time-outs remain, a technical foul for delaying the game shall be charged on the Head Coach of Team GC Foster
  - d. All the above
  
2. Team GC Foster's Head Coach requests a time-out. Team UWI is charged with an unsportsmanlike foul against GC Foster, followed by a technical foul on team UWI. Will the time -out be granted to team GC Foster?
  - a. Team GC Foster is granted a time-out. After the time-out, Team GC Foster player shall attempt free throws with no line-up
  - b. No time-out will be granted to Team GC Foster. No free throw will be awarded to Team GC foster
  - c. Team GC Foster is granted a time-out. After the time-out, Team GC Foster player shall attempt 1 free throw with players line-up
  - d. Team GC Foster is granted a time-out. After the time-out, Team GC Foster will be awarded free points
  
3. Player Daley is close to the side-line, with the ball in his hands. He is closely guarded by player Senior from the opposing team. Player Daley makes body contact with Player Senior, who has 1 foot out-of-bounds. Will this be considered a legal play?
  - a. Yes, the ball will be awarded to player Senior
  - b. Yes, Player Daley will be given a technical foul
  - c. Yes, this is a legal play by Player Daley
  - d. Yes, Player Senior will be given a technical foul

4. Player Parker has not yet dribbled and is standing still. He throws the ball against the backboard and catches or touches the ball again before it touches another player. Which scenario is most appropriate to player Parker's action?

  - b. Double dribble violation will be called against the player for his deliberate actions

5. Player Burton from team GC Foster, with the ball in his hands, loses his balance during a play and falls on the playing court. Select the appropriate answers based on the scenario given.

  - b. It is legal if a player who is holding the ball falls on the playing court.
  - c. It is legal if a player, after falling on the playing court with the ball, slides due to his momentum.
  - d. All the above.
  
6. Brown a player from team GC Foster dribbles the ball and comes to a two foot stop. Player Michael then attempts a pass to Player Pryce another player from GC Foster. The pass is not touched by any other player on the court. Brown picks up his own pass. Will the official call for a double dribble?
  - a. It is an illegal or double dribble violation because by rule, a player cannot after ending a dribble make a pass or fumble the ball and be the first to touch the ball
  - b. It is not an illegal double dribble violation because by rule the player is allowed to pick up the ball after ending a dribble, make a pass or if the ball fumbles
  - c. The player is allowed regain control of the ball and continue to dribble the ball based on the discretion of the referee
  - d. The player fumbles the ball, but the referee instructs the player to pick up the ball and continue play because other teammates are open for a pass
  
7. While the game clock is running, player Angus gains a new possession of the ball on the court during a play. State the time that will be given to the team that gains possession.
  - a. That team shall have 14 seconds on the shot clock
  - b. That team shall have a new 16 seconds on the shot clock
  - c. That team shall have a new 24 seconds on the shot clock
  - d. That team shall have a new 25 seconds on the shot clock

8. Player Smith from GC Foster who is in his backcourt, passes the ball to Williams in his frontcourt. Player Brown from UTECH jumps from his frontcourt, catches the ball while airborne and lands. Select the response based on player Brown's action.
- He may not pass the ball to a team-mate in his backcourt before landing.
  - He is allowed to pass the ball to a team-mate in his backcourt before landing.
  - The referee will allow the player to pass to team-mate in his backcourt before landing.
  - There is no rule to justify the player's action.
9. After Player Gibbs from GC Foster shot for a field goal, the ball rebounds off the ring and then lands on the ring. Player Blair from UTECH touches the basket or backboard while the ball is on the ring. Is this an interference committed by Player Blair from UTECH?
- This is an interference play by GC Foster
  - This is not interference play by GC Foster
  - This is an interference violation by UTECH
  - This is not an interference play by Utech
10. Player Wilson from GC Foster is in the air on the shot for a 3-point field goal. Wilson extends his leg which contacts the defensive player Johnson from UWI. Was there a foul committed by the player in the act of shooting?
- This is a blocking foul against Johnson

11. On a field goal try by Hawthorne from team GC Foster, the ball is bouncing directly above the ring when Robinson from Team MICO touches the ring. The official rules basket interference because

12. Player Black from team GC Foster is in the act of shooting when she was fouled by Lewis, a player from team Shortwood. The ball is then released and enters the basket. Will the referee call for a continuation?

13. Situation: Team GC Foster is inbounding the ball from the baseline. In an attempt to throw a length of court pass, Team GC Foster throws the ball through the opposite baseline. The ball has touched no player, no backboard or rim or even the floor in bounds. Where will the ball be awarded to the opposing team.?
- At the point where the ball went out of bounds
  - At the six second line on the right side

14. During the act of shooting, player Simpson from GC Foster has the ball in both hands when he is fouled by Player Wright from the opposing team. After the foul, Player Simpson passes to a teammate. Shall player Simpson be awarded free throws?

15. Player Golding is in the restricted area for less than 3 seconds when player Golding moves to out-of-bounds at the end line in order to avoid a 3-second violation and then re-enters the restricted area. Select the BEST response to player Golding's action.
- Player is not allowed to re-enter restricted area
  - Player is allowed to re-enter restricted area
  - Player is allowed to stay more than 3 second after first violation
  - Player will be allowed in restricted area by referee after first violation

16. All of the following are true statements regarding lane spaces being occupied during free throws, EXCEPT
- a maximum of four defensive and two offensive players are permitted.
  - the first marked lane spaces may be occupied by the defense or offense.
  - the lane areas from the end line, up to and including the neutral-zone marks, shall remain vacant.
  - players who do not occupy a marked lane space, other than the thrower, must be behind the free-throw line extended and behind the three-point arc.
17. Taylor, the 24 second shot clock operator, shall stop the time but not reset to 24 seconds, when the following occurs during the game
- the game is stopped because the referee is not sure if a foul was committed.
  - the game is stopped because of an action not connected with either team unless the opponents would be placed at a disadvantage.
  - the game is stopped because the ball touches the backboard after a miss shot.

20. Scenario: With 1:00 min remaining on the game clock in the fourth quarter, team GC Foster is entitled to a throw-in. Before handing the ball to a player from GC Foster, the official shows the warning signal for an illegal boundary line crossing. A player's hand from the opposing team was extended over the boundary line towards the GC Foster player before the ball has been thrown in. What call should the official make based on the players actions?
- Ask player to step back from the line to allow the player to inbound the ball
  - Issue a technical against the player for failing to step back from the line based on the referee instructions
  - A double foul will be called between the team on offense and the team on defense
  - Player on defense will be asked to leave the court for committing a violation

- State FOUR instances when a player can be awarded a free throw throughout the game. (4 marks)
- Table officials play a vital role in the game. Outline TWO duties each of the scorer before, during and after the game. (6 marks)

**Answer Question 1 and ANY other question from this Section**

### 1. Transfer the following information to the Scoresheet provided.

- a. It is the 7th game of the Intercol Basketball League and Team MICO will oppose Team G C Foster at GC FOSTER GYM. Today's game will start at 3:00 pm and will be officiated by Jim Taylor who will be assisted by Troy Green. The Timekeeper is J. Clarke and You are the Scorer. (5 marks)
- b. Team GC Foster College will be represented by players: C Brown (6), L White (9), G. Black captain (13), T Thomas (43) A Grey (22), Q Sinclair (11) C Morgan (8), B Innis (17) and E Hines (53). They will be coached by Rick Taylor with assistance from A Powell. The starters will be numbers 22, 11, 17, 8 and 53.
- Team MICO will be represented by players: E Steele (15), F Westfield (4), A Young (9), M Jordon Captain (23), K Bryant (25), R Grant (35) and S Lewis (14). They will be coached by Phil Patterson with assistance from R Grace. The starters will be numbers 25, 14, 15, 35 and 9. (5 marks)
- c. At the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> period the scores were Team A- 22 and Team B-18. At half time Team B added 15 more points while Team A- added 25 more points. Players will be referred to as A22, A11 or B25, B14 etc going into the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. (5 marks)
- d. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> period players A22, B25 and A11 scored from the 3-point area and B35, A17, B9 and B14 scored from the 2pt area. Coach Phil Patterson was granted a time-out in the third quarter; B25, A22, A11, A17, A53, B15 and B35 committed personal fouls and B14 a Technical. (5 marks)
- e. In the 4<sup>th</sup> period B15 fouled A22 and he was given three free throws – he scored two of the three free throws; A8 fouled B25 who was shooting from the 2pt area – the shot missed but he scored all the free throws given to him; A17 was fouled in the act of shooting from the 3pt area – he scored the shot and the free throw penalty. (Total 20 marks)
