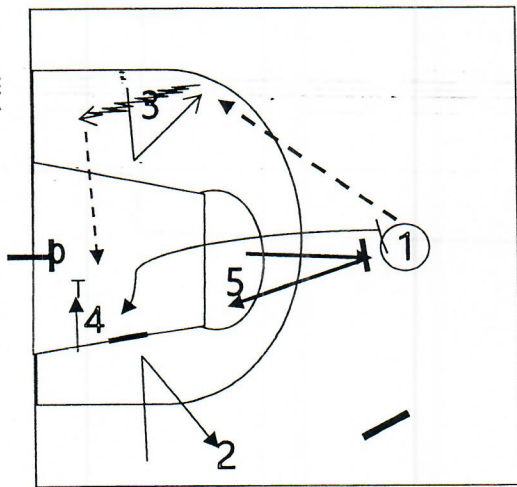

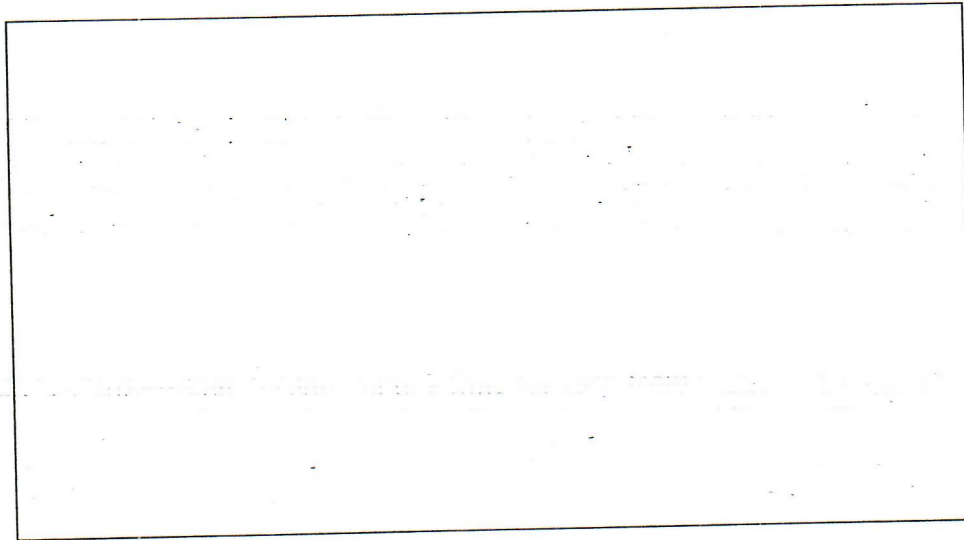
1. Draw any offensive set, and explain the following:
