Transfer the following information to the Scoresheet provided

- 1) **A.** It is the THIRD game of the Intercol Basketball League and Team UWI will oppose Team GC Foster at GC FOSTER GYM. Today's game will start at 6:30pm and the game will be refereed by Christopher Brown and will be assisted by Michael Johnson. The Timekeeper is K Simpson and You are the Scorer.

B. Team GC Foster College will be represented by players: T. Johnson (2), C. Brown (3), K. White (5) Captain, B. Powell (7) J. Jackson (9), K. Bryant 23, M Jordan (11), L. Palmer (12), and D. Rose (14). They will be coached by Phil Jackson with assistance from R Ryley. The starters will be numbers 2, 5, 7, 9 and 14.

Team UWI will be represented by players: M. Wilson (4), R. Davis (6), S. Samuels (8), G. Coombs (13) Captain, D. Pryce (17), D. Green (20) and O. walker (21). They will be coached by Calvin Martin with assistance from Jim Kessler. The starters will be numbers 4, 6, 13, 17 and 20.

C. At the end of the 1st period the scores were: Team A- 20 and Team B-15.
