**SECTION A (20 marks)**  
**Do ALL questions in this section.**

1. On a field goal try by Mark Simpson from A team, the ball is bouncing directly above the ring when Paul Spence from B team touches the ring. The official rules basket interference because
  - a) once the ball touches the ring, team a player may legally attempt to direct the ball into the basket.
  - b) the ball touches the basket so team b players may legally knock the ball away and prevent a score.
  - c) the mere touching of the ring has no impact on either of these situations and is legal.
  - d) all the above apply.
  
2. Damaine Thorpe from team A is in the act of shooting when he was fouled by Jermaine Allwood, a player from team B. The ball was then released and entered the basket. The referee will make a call for
  - a) no continuation on team control fouls if the ball is still in the shooter's hand.
  - b) continuation on team foul because the ball is still in shooters hand.
  - c) continuation on team foul because the shooter was fouled before releasing the ball and basket scored after the contact.
  - d) the shooter to be granted the basket because the shooter was fouled in the act of shooting.
  
3. Michael Jackson from team A dribbles the ball and comes to a two- foot stop. He then attempts a pass to a Daniel Pryce another player from team A. The pass is not touched by any other player on the court. Michael picks up his own pass. The official decided that

1. **A.** It is the 5th game of the Intercol Basketball League and Team MONEAGUE will oppose Team G C Foster at GC FOSTER GYM. Today's game will start at 6:00pm and the game will be officiated by Romaine Virgo who will be assisted by John Brown. The Timekeeper is C. Johnson and You are the Scorer.

- B.** Team GC Foster College will be represented by players: M. Johnson (6), K. Brown (9), V. Thompson captain (13), O. Simpson (43) T. White (22), P. Lloyd (11) K. Lewis (8), K. Samuels (17) and H. Malcolm (53). They will be coached by Levar Rose with assistance from Galton Taylor. The starters will be numbers 8, 13, 43, 9 and 6.  
  
Team UWI will be represented by players: G. Facey (15), T. Riley (4), C. Clark (9), C. O'Neil (23) Captain, D. Kempt (25), K. James (35) and R. Morgan (14). They will be coached by M. Thorpe with assistance from M Gordon. The starters will be numbers 15, 23, 35, 9 and 4.

- C.** At the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> period the scores were Team A- 25 and Team B-20. At half time Team B added 18 more points while Team A- added 20 more points. Players will be referred to as A6, A8 or B15, B9 etc going into the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.

- D.** In the 3<sup>rd</sup> period players A43, B9 and A13 scored from the 3-point area and B23, A 6, B4 and B35 scored from the 2pt area. Coach M. Thorpe was granted a time-out in the third quarter; B9, A43, A6, A13, A8, B9 and B15 committed personal fouls.
